The Concorde Fire Flames program for children 7-8 years old meets twice a week and Concorde Fire staff coaches conduct all sessions. Training will focus on basic soccer technical skill training and personal skill development. In addition we will include small-sided games, give players an opportunity to get a feel for the bigger field and coaches will incorporate the idea of field positioning. There are no tryouts for the Flames program and registration is based on space availability.
